

Happy International Women's Day!



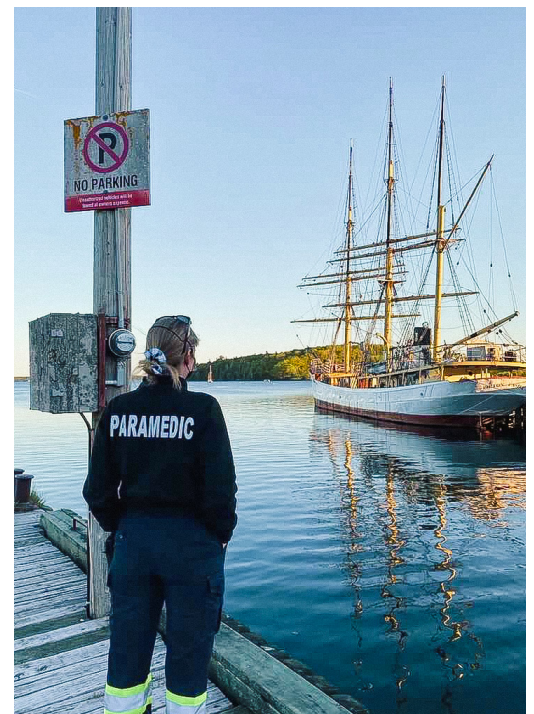
Thank you for celebrating International Women's Day with us.
